

ELITE Sportsbook Frequently Asked Questions

Q: At what age can I place a sports wager?

A: Guests must be 21 years or older to wager at Grand Island Casino, This includes the ELITE Sportsbook.

Q: Do I need to show identification to place a sports bet?

A: Any guest that appears under the age of 30 may be asked to show a valid ID.

Q: Can I use my resort card for sports wagering?

A: You cannot use your resort card for sports wagers.

Q: What are the hours of operation?

A: ELITE Sportsbook hours may vary due to sports seasons or business demand. You can place sportsbook wagers at our kiosks during casino open hours. If the sportsbook is closed, guests may redeem winning sportsbook wagers at the Casino Cage.

Q: Is there a minimum bet amount?

A: ELITE Sportsbook will determine minimum and maximum wagers?

Q: Are there betting limits?

A: The maximum wager varies according to the specific sport being wagered.

Q: What is the maximum amount I can win?

A: The maximum payout odds on parlays is 299 to 1

Q: What forms of payment are acceptable to place a bet?

A: ELITE Sportsbook only accepts cash transactions

Q: Do winning wagers ever expire?

A: Yes, Winning wagers are valid for 90 days after the event concludes.

Q: Are sportsbook winnings taxable?

A: Winnings from sports wagers are subject to IRS reporting and withholding rules, if applicable. Individual winning wagers that are at least \$600 and have payout odds over 300/1 are taxable and will be processed with a W2G.

Q: Can I have someone place a wager for me?

A: No, proxy betting is prohibited. It is also prohibited to have them cash wagers for you?

Q: Can I place a bet on Nebraska-based college sports teams?

A: A wager may not be placed on a pro or collegiate Nebraskan team or athlete while they are playing in the state of Nebraska. A wager may be placed on a Nebraskan team when they play outside the state of Nebraska. As defined in Nebraska Statute 9-1103

Q: Is there a way to redeem my ticket without coming to the sports book?

A: Winning wagers may be redeemed in person at the sportsbook or cage after the sportsbook is closed. You may also mail in your ticket by filling out the information on the back and sending it in for a check to be sent.

Q: Can I place wagers through an app on my phone?

A: At this time the state of Nebraska has only approved on site wagering for Sports betting.

Q: Can I use my resort card for sports wagering?

A: You cannot use your resort card for sports wagers.
